





Japanese encephalitis, although rare in travellers, is a severe inflammation of the brain caused by a mosquito-borne infection, that results in death in 20-to-30% of people with symptomatic disease.⁵⁶



skin cancer (12% in AUS per year)⁷ & diabetes (4% in AUS per year)^{8,9} combined if symptomatic Japanese encephalitis is contracted.


